The **Slovenian Cyber Resilience Lab** acts as a regional support centre for start-ups and other smaller R&D organisations with tackling all cybersecurity related issues. The lab focuses on spreading cybersecurity awareness, providing training, and sharing knowledge, by bringing together various stakeholders that shape **Slovenian start-up communities**, as well as stakeholders from the Slovenian cybersecurity sector. Furthermore, SRCL focuses on exploring which challenges the future will bring to cybersecurity management, as well as seeking policy solutions, which would efficiently secure the cyberspace of the future. Since cybersecurity is becoming interconnected with every aspect of our private and professional lives, we aim to propose policies that address multiple future crises hotspots – even if they may not seem connected on first sight.

From an employee at a young start-up, to the decision-maker on the national level, the Slovenian Cyber Resilience Lab will connect actors on operational and strategic level to identify and implement the best possible solutions for tackling cybersecurity threats of present and future.

Challenges



The Slovenian Cyber Resilience Lab focuses on the following challenges:

- **How do start-ups respond to cybersecurity threats?** At the moment, there is no reliable information on how start-ups respond to current cybersecurity threats.
- **Which future crises will have an impact on the ability of the start-up to secure its cyberspace?** Due to the rapid digitalisation of every aspect of the modern life it is getting harder and harder to imagine a crisis that would not somehow impact cybersecurity.
- **How will the start-up community respond to the future challenges?** The rapid technological development and fast changing threat landscape requires lean and flexible policies that will overlap with several other fields.

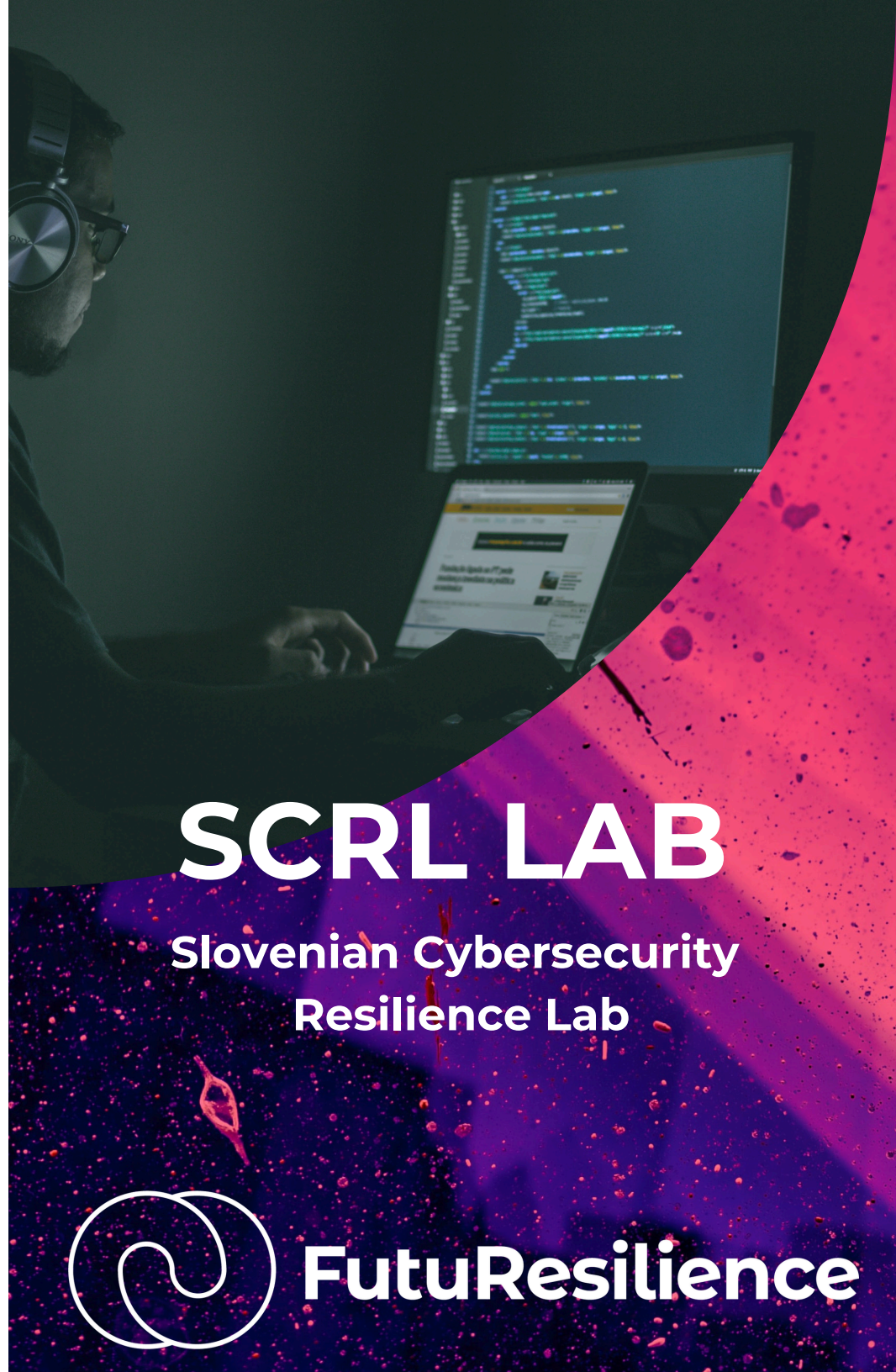
